

We recommend that you start your accommodation search as soon as possible. Here are resources and tips for you:

Please note that in order to register and activate your CPR number in Denmark, you must show a housing lease or documentation that you have a place to live for a minimum of one month. Without an activated CPR number, you are not covered by health insurance and cannot open a bank account. Therefore, it is essential that you secure housing before registration and ideally before your arrival to Denmark.

LEASE CONTRACT

The official lease contract in Denmark is only provided in Danish. However, there is an English translation available here. This is not an authorized translation, but it will give you an accurate overview.
